

Committee for Professional Opportunities for Women (CPOW) Travel Award Application

Deadline: October 3, 2010

To assist a small number of female postdoctoral fellows, the Biophysical Society's Committee for Professional Opportunities for Women has limited funds available for travel fellowships to the 2011 Biophysical Society Annual Meeting. Each award may be applied towards travel to and from the Annual Meeting. The purpose of these travel fellowships is to increase the number of women biophysicists and encourage their participation at the Annual Meeting.

Participants must submit a completed application form including all required documents.

The following eligibility requirements must be met:

- 1. Applicant must be a female postdoctoral fellow.
- 2. Applicant must be presenting a poster or oral presentation at the Annual Meeting.
- 3. Applicant must be a member of the Biophysical Society with 2011 dues paid by the application deadline, October 3, 2010.

The following materials are required at the time of submission by each applicant:

- 1. Completed application form, including brief description of your career path and goals.
- 2. A copy of the abstract submitted for presentation at the Annual Meeting.
- 3. Applicant's curriculum vitae (no more than 2 pages).
- 4. A signed letter (no more than 1 page) from the applicant's mentor, addressing the following:
 - Confirmation of applicant's postdoctoral status
 - Assessment of applicant's scientific potential
 - Importance of this award on applicant's future career

Please note: Because this is a travel award, applicants must be present at the Annual Meeting in order to receive the award. Awardees will be recognized at the Annual Meeting.
