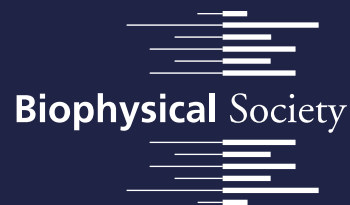


Undergraduate Student “Breakfast”
