### **Madeline Shea to Receive 2018 Emily M. Gray Award**

Rockville, MD — The Biophysical Society is pleased to announce that Madeline Shea, Professor of Biochemistry, University of Iowa Carver College of Medicine, has been named the recipient of the Society's 2018 Emily M. Gray Award. She will be honored at the Society's 62<sup>nd</sup> Annual Meeting at the Moscone Center in San Francisco, California, on Monday, February 19, 2018, during the Awards Ceremony preceding the National Lecture.

Shea is being honored for her outstanding contributions to Biophysics education at all educational levels in local, regional, and national communities. The Emily M. Gray Award is given for significant contributions to education in biophysics.
